Wai Nui O Kanaka Outrigger Canoe Club is having a season opening Hawaiian Luau at noon on Sunday June 11 at Burloak Canoe Club, downtown Oakville, in conjunction with the Rick Hansen Wheels In Motion event.

The club is celebrating our new club boats, purchased with funding from the Ontario Thrillium Foundation.

New paddlers and those more experienced can see a variety of boats, and go for a paddle. Wai Nui Outrigger has coaching expertise that will benefit new paddlers and those seeking world-class racing opportunities.

This sport, native to Polynesia, is growing locally, with several local regattas, including an

internationally sanctioned race around Toronto Island July 8th this year. Wai Nui, funded in part by the Ontario Thrillium Foundation, has grown to be the largest outrigger club in eastern Canada. There are multiple crew boats (6 man), as well as small boats (2 man and singles) going out 7 times a week, Monday to Thursday evenings, mornings at 6 am, Saturday and Sunday mornings and afternoon.
